1. Motion to approve Agenda:

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. No bids were received for ammunition.
- 2. Seven vendors submitted bids for chip seal, hot mix, cold mix and oil for roads. D. Botts made a motion and T. Selvey seconded to accept the bid for hot mix and cold mix from Blevins Asphalt. Roll call vote was unanimous. The bid for chip seal will be awarded next week.
- 3. Dennis Rogers will be asked to proposed repairs for the Jail entry door and reinforcement in the booking room. There is also deteriorating woodwork on the rear exterior of the patrol office that he will look at.
- 4. The annual Road District meeting will be held on April 11th following the General Municipal Election.
- 5. D. Botts made a motion and T. Selvey seconded to approve Court Order #1684 concerning additions and abatements for February. Roll call vote was unanimous.
- 6. S. Goodman made a motion and T. Selvey seconded to accept Eddie Breeding's bid to mow the Woodsland Cemetery for \$75 per mowing. Roll call vote was unanimous.
- 7. The light poles in front of the Justice Center are loose and leaning toward the building. The flagpole in the front of the Courthouse is cracked and the rope fails to function when the flag needs to be raised or lowered.
- 8. Dave Jacobs, Larry Murray and Robert Bateman discussed a bridge in the Buck Prairie Road District that has a load limit that is insufficient to accommodate a school bus. Its replacement was discussed.
