## NEW BUSINESS:

1. The Commissioners and the Prosecuting Attorney went to Greene County to look at the temporary jail facilities that are being installed to alleviate overcrowding.
2. S. Goodman made a motion and T. Selvey seconded to approve Court Order #1674 concerning additions and abatements for October. Roll call vote was unanimous.
3. S. Goodman made a motion and T. Selvey seconded to approve the payment of an invoice from the City of Monett for 911 dispatching in the amount of \$21,233.45, from the Judicial Sales Tax Fund. The balance in the 911 Fund and the General Revenue Fund are both too low to pay this bill. Roll call vote was unanimous.
4. D. Botts made a motion and S. Goodman seconded to sign a letter of support for the Community Foundation of Cassville to partner with the Community Foundation of Aurora to provide mental health Telehealth services to citizens. Roll call vote was unanimous.
5. The boiler system in the courthouse is not working properly. It is making loud noises and violent vibrations. The custodian has shut it down and the offices are using electric space heaters.
6. The commission and Janella Spencer discussed the use of the health department for a community clinic staffed by MSU and paid for by a grant.
