

Commission Minutes

July 15, 2019 the 12th day of the July term of Court

Commissioners Present: Bob Senninger, Tim Selvey, David Botts

Tim Selvey made a motion and David Botts seconded to approve the agenda. Roll call vote was unanimous.

Tim Selvey made a motion and Bob Senninger seconded to approve the minutes of July 11, 2019.

Roll call vote was unanimous.

David Botts made a motion and Bob Senninger seconded to approve the amendment to the WIC contract. This amendment reduced the amount given for training in the current contract. Funds were not used at training.

At 9:00 the Board of Equalization convened.

All parties that appealed to the BOE were given a written report of the decision of the Board and instructions about appealing to the State Tax Commission if they so desired. These and all other documents are kept in the files of the County Clerk's office for inspection.
